Presentation styles will include lecture, demonstration, PowerPoint slides, video, interactive questioning, discussion, workbook exercises and class participation.

Course Objectives: This course is designed to assist the operator in preparing for the South Carolina "D" and "C" Biological Wastewater Certification Exam. At completion of this course, the operator should be able to:

1. Perform math functions such as basic operations, operations with fractions, decimals, conversions, percentages and simple problem-solving.
2. Perform more advanced math functions such as problem-solving with equations.
3. Define terms common to biological wastewater treatment.
4. List basic wastewater characteristics.
5. List and describe the various biological treatment processes and their operations.
6. Describe the various support systems and their components associated with biological treatment processes.
7. List and describe the lab analyses associated with these processes and the proper lab techniques and safety precautions involved.
8. Describe maintenance procedures associated with the biological treatment plant and equipment.
9. Describe the safety procedures associated with biological plants and equipment.

Please bring a calculator to class; lunch, practice exam on CD and handouts and pens will be provided.

A record of your attendance will be kept on file and a certificate of completion will be issued to each attendee.
